PERENNIAL HERB

Height 2.3'

Leaves basal, lanceolate, 2-10" long, hairy.

Flowers pale to bright yellow in large heads on long pedicels; April - July.

Native Habitat: Uncommon on serpentine gravels to 8000' in northwest California to Washington and Idaho.

Full to partial sun.

Well-drained, gravelly soils.

May need late spring/summer water in drier, hotter zones

As a serpentine soil dweller, it may do well in poor soils.
