PERENNIAL GRASS 1' high, 1-2' wide Fast growing, densely clumped bunchgrass. Leaves green to chalky blue or blue-gray. Flowers in summer.

Siskiyou Blue cultivar is a blue-gray selection

Native Habitat: dry, open or shady places, northwest N. America south to central California, < 6000'.

Full sun to partial shade. Wide variety of soils and drainage. Drought tolerant once established. Water 0-1x/month in summer.

Summer dormant. Can be mowed high after flowering. Cold tolerant to -10F.
