PERENNIAL GRASS 3'-10' high, 3'-6' wide Robust green, round, upright stems. Relatively short leaves at base of stems. Flowers small in terminal panicles, appearing brown.

Native Habitat: Wetlands and marshes of southwest, to 8500'.

Full sun Needs saturated soils, standing water.

Good in ponds, or very wet swales.
